The Gestapo arrested Milena on November 11, 1939 and imprisoned her first in Prague's Pankrác and later in Dresden. Three letters from Zedwitz found in her apartment contained information that led also to his arrest and detention for 15 months.

In October 1940, Milena was deported to Ravensbrück concentration camp for women in northern Germany.

But even throughout her time in Ravensbrück concentration camp, Milena was by all accounts brave and optimistic and provided large moral support to other prisoners.

Due to the camp conditions her health deteriorated, she lost her sight and died of kidney failure on May 17, 1944, three weeks before D-Day.
